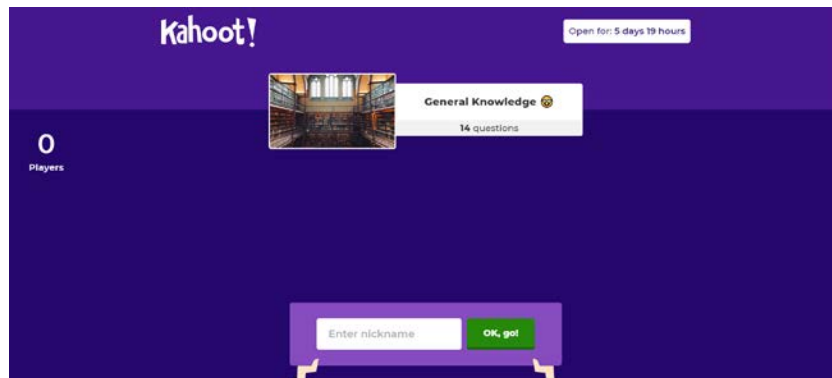
How to use Kahoot!

To join a game, you'll need a device with a supported browser and a stable internet connection. Kahoot! is compatible with the latest versions of Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge, and Internet Explorer.



Our client learning team will send you a link to the Kahoot! interactive game via a call to action pop up. This will redirect and open the game lobby within a new tab in your browser.

Alternatively, navigate to the [Kahoot! website](https://kahoot.it/) and enter the game pin we've provided. If you have any issues, you can use the Kahoot! website from your mobile. We'll include details in the Livestorm chat during the webinar.



Enter your nickname, and press **OK, go!** – you will then be taken straight to the activity.

Some activities have a time limit, so keep an eye on the clock.
